
IMPORTANT NOTICE



Step 1:


Find (K) the Five Star Base and push the

(L) Castors into the bottom of the base.




Step 2:

Place the N Cylinder in the middle of the base.




Step 3:

Now slide the O Black Bellow over the Cylinder.



Step 4:

Take the J Seat and turn it upside down so you can see the holes. Take the M Base Plate & Tilt Mechanism place on bottom of Seat J . The Big knob goes towards the front of the chair. Line up the holes and secure with 4 C M6x25mm Bolts using the E Small Allen Wrench.




Step 5:

Take the (H) arms so the black curved part faces the front of the chair.


Line up the arm with the 3 holes on the bottom of the seat \bigcirc . The holes make a triangle shape.

Secure to the Chair with 3 B M6x30mm bolts using the E small Allen Wrench




Step 6:

Take (G) Back Rest Cushion with Lumbar Support and slide the metal tab into the M and line up the holes. Now take A M6x20mm and tighten with the F Large Allen Wrench. Repeat this process for the other two remaining bolts.



Step 7:

Place the pump which is already attached to the Back Rest G on the right side of the chair which should be the only remaining holes left. Fasten with C M6x25mm Bolts using the E Small Allen Wrench.



Step 7:

Take the assembled top part of the chair (Backrest and seat) and place over the cylinder in the open hole on the attached base.



Adjusting the Martin CEO EZ Chair

- The Lever on the right hand side is for adjusting the height of your chair. You need to be in the chair for it to go down.
- The Lumbar support is the knob on the Right side of the chair. If you twist it forward it goes up and if you twist backwards it gets softer.
- The lever on the Left hand side of the chair locks the back in place or releases it allowing you to recline.
- The Large Knob on the bottom of the chair adjusts the pressure it takes to recline.
